- Applicants must be U.S. Citizens, possess a valid driver's license and a minimum of a high school diploma or GED equivalent.
- Applicants must be at a minimum of 21 years of age and less than 40 years of age, unless already a member of the 1977 Police/Firefighter Fund.
- Applicants must be able to pass a thorough background check.
- Applicants may be required to submit to a physical agility test and other testing that may be deemed appropriate.

Benefits:

- 2026 1st Class Patrolman annual salary ranges from \$69,288-\$76,788 (based on years of experience and guaranteed holiday pay.)
- 1977 IN Police Perf Pension, the city contributes the full 23.50% for the officer.
- 12-hour shifts (84 hours bi-weekly) and take-home vehicles (within 25-mile radius of Police Department).
- Longevity Pay of \$500 per year of service. Lateral hires will have their years of service honored up to 15 years.
- Annual Clothing allowance of \$775.
- Paid Time Off (PTO).
- One hour of on-duty workout time.
- Department issued cell phone.
- Health, Vision, and Dental Insurance coverage after 90 Days (single \$120 per month/family \$200 per month).
