BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY
October 14, 2020

Mayor Weiss called the meeting to order.

There were no minutes for approval.

Mayor Weiss asked for approval of the bills and claims. **BOW Member Karsteter made a motion to approve all bills and claims properly submitted against the City. With a second by BOW Member Bowell, the motion carried by voice 2-0.**

Chief Uhlman presented the Police Report for **September**. He stated that they've been very busy this month.

Chief Craig presented the **Fire Report for September**. He stated that there were 15 calls with a 9-minute response time. He concluded that Dearborn County has issued a burn band, no opening burning. There were no questions.

Tom Craig presented the **EMS Report for September**. He stated there were 40 calls for the month and 360 calls for the year. The response time was 3-minutes. There were no questions.

Mayor commented that in 2021 he would like the safety heads to get back to giving a quarterly report to Council.

Mayor Weiss asked if there were any audience comments. There were none.


City Manager Lampert reported the following:

- 1) **Valley Woods & Oberting Road Culvert Pipes:** City Mgr. reported that they were working on Glen Eagle to Running Deer. They've installed pipe and curbing to take the water downhill.


- 2) **Persimmon & St Andrews Lane Mill and Pave:** All of the culvert pipes have been installed. They will regrade some of the ditches. City Mgr. Lampert added that he has asked O'Mara to look at State Line Road in front of Baleco (*approx. 400 ft*).
- 3) **Ridge Avenue Community Crossings Grant (Probasco Ave):** City Mgr. Lampert stated that he has the Application ready to send to INDOT. **The total cost of the project is \$522,095.** The City's portion is \$130,523.75 (25%) and the State's portion is \$391,571.25 (75%). He reminded the Board that Ridge, Probasco and Nowlin are all classified roads according to the grant.
- 4) **Anchor Sub:** City Mgr. reported that the city is ready to start wiring poles. He commented that he is just waiting for Anchor to shut down.
- 5) **Ridge Avenue 34.5kV Transmission Line:** City Mgr. Lampert stated that Lauren Hill Lane to Belleview will feed Anchor Glass.
- 6) **SDRSD:** Mayor Weiss indicated that they would give the Board updates as they have information to report. City Mgr. Lampert indicated they are applying for an economic development grant and low interest money. There was lengthy discussion. Mayor Weiss added that there was concern about the management of the board. He said that all three cities agreed to hire Envirolink to take over management. During their management's new term, things started breaking down because there was no preventive maintenance for years. He stated that the plant is old, but it's headed in the right direction to become efficient. The Mayor concluded that after time, the plant should be working and managed properly.
- 7) **Project Update:** The Board had copies in front of them. City Mgr. Lampert stated that Televac is tving Sugar Ridge. The City Manager mentioned that he's asked the Clerk to add the "Master Drainage Project" to the Agenda. He stated that he's been giving the Board updates.
- 8) **IMPA:** Mayor Weiss reported that all meetings are still virtual.

There was no new business.

There being no further business to come before the Board, **BOW member Karsteter made a motion to adjourn. With a second by BOW Member Bowell, the meeting adjourned.**
