

**CITY OF GREENDALE
Council Meeting
September 9, 2015**

Prior to the Council meeting, **Aurora Fire Chief Jeff Lane and Deputy Fire Chief Mark Lane presented a plaque to Greendale Fire Chief Shannon Craig for the Fire Department and the EMS/Life Squad's assistance and their appreciation with the Aurora Lumber fire a couple weeks ago.**

Mayor Hedrick called the meeting to order.

Mayor Hedrick asked for approval of the August 20, 2015 minutes. **Councilman Bowell made a motion to approve the August 20, 2015. With a second by Councilman Wilson, the motion carried by voice 6 to 0.**

Mayor Hedrick commented that the **City has waived the \$25 fee for the Loving Grandmothers to hold meetings in the cabin for the past year.** He asked if the Board agreed to waive the fee for the next year. **Councilman Bischoff made a motion to waive the \$25 fee for the cabin. With a second by Councilman Karsteter, the motion carried by voice 6 to 0.**

Carolyn Stuard appeared on behalf of the **"Jingle Bell Run"**. She asked for Council's permission for the Voices of Indiana to hold the 5K Walk & Run on Saturday, December 5, 2015 beginning at 9:30am. After discussion, **Councilman Bischoff made a motion to allow Voices of Indiana to hold the run and use the cabin. With a second by Councilman Abdon, the motion carried by voice 6 to 0.**

Angie Bauer was caught in traffic and asked Mayor Hedrick to speak on her behalf asking if the **non-profit organization "Not One More"** could walk a 5K from Agner Hall onto

Main Street to Ridge Avenue (in Greendale) on October 17, 2015. The run would begin in Lawrenceburg and would continue into Greendale. The Mayor stated that this was a fundraiser to educate and make people aware of heroin. After discussion, **Councilman Bischoff made a motion to allow the event. With a second by Councilman Karsteter, the motion carried by voice 6 to 0.**

PG Gentrup asked for the City of Greendale to **sponsor a bus for the veterans to attend a Cincinnati Reds Game (honoring Lauren Hill).** Councilman Lansing motioned to **sponsor the bus in the amount of \$700. With a second by Councilman Bischoff, the motion carried by voice 6 to 0.**

Mayor Hedrick asked if there were any audience comments. There were none.

Mayor Hedrick reminded Council that there was a **Public Hearing for the 2016 Budget on 9/28/15 @ 6:00pm** and then following the hearing at 6:10pm the Planning Commission would begin.




Code Enforcement Officer McMullen went over the monthly Report. He stated that there were 38 vacant houses. There was brief discussion about the Western Minerals Property and costs of invoicing the demolition. There were no further questions.


Councilman Abdon made a motion to approve the August 25, 2015 Special Council Minutes with a correction to pg. 1, end of the first paragraph wherein it states "He stated that the project will bring 34 new jobs to Greendale." The sentence should be changed to say: **"He stated that the project will bring 24 new full-time and 4 part-time jobs to Greendale."** **With a second by Councilman Wilson, the motion carried by voice 6 to 0.**


Mayor Hedrick received a letter from the County Auditor stating that the previous **Interlocal Agreement for sharing Riverboat Lobbyist will not be up for renewal in 2016** because all entities have opted to not pay for a lobbyist. Councilman Wilson asked if Greendale wanted to do anything. Mayor Hedrick and the Board agreed that Greendale has opted out as well and therefore is going to do nothing at this time.

There being no further business to come before the board, Councilman Karsteter made a motion to adjourn. With a second by Councilman Bischoff, the motion carried by voice 6 to 0.






