January 25, 2016

Mayor Weiss called the meeting to order.

Mayor Weiss asked for approval of the January 13, 2016 minutes. **Councilman McCool made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. With a second by Councilman Bowell the motion carried by voice 7 to 0.**

There were no audience comments.

The Mayor explained that when announcing his 2016 Appointments at the January 13 meeting, he inadvertently did not announce that **John Commons was also one of his appointments to the Planning Commission.** He apologized for the oversight.

Mayor Weiss proceeded to say that in accordance with *IC 36-7-4-902*, it states that the Board of Zoning Appeals must have 4 members of which *cannot be an elected official* and must be "*citizens*". Because at the January 13 meeting, Council's appointment was Councilman Matt McCool, Mayor Weiss asked for Council to rescind the motion and make a new motion appointing a "*citizen*". **Councilman Karsteter made a motion to rescind the appointment of Matt McCool to the BZA. With a second by Councilman Abbott, the motion carried by voice 7 to 0. Councilman Abbott made a motion to appoint Reid Hensley to the BZA. With a second by Councilman Karsteter, the motion carried by voice 7 to 0.**

Councilman Wilson made motion to remove himself from Planning Commission, with a second by Councilman Karsteter, the motion carried by voice 7 to 0.

Councilman Wilson made a motion as Council's appointment, to appoint Councilman Matt McCool to the Planning Commission. With a second by Councilman Bowell, the motion carried by voice 7 to 0.

With regard to both the 2016-2017-2018 Police and Civil Union Contracts, Councilman Bowell brought Council up to par that at the Committee's last meeting they had agreed on adding a new section "*Post Accident Drug Testing*" to both contracts. Councilman Bowell stated that Council can pass both contracts contingent upon the Union voting to approve the addition of the *Post Accident Drug Testing*. He stated that Scott Rich was going to meeting the City representatives to obtain signatures.

After discussion and referring to the City Personnel Policy about disciplinary action if an employee is tested positive for drugs or alcohol after an accident, Councilman Karsteter motioned to approve the Police Union Contract contingent upon the union approval of the *Post Accident Drug Testing* clause that was just added. With a second by Councilman Abbott, the motion carried by voice 7 to 0.

Councilman Karsteter motioned to approve the Civil Union Contract contingent upon the union approval of the *Post Accident Drug Testing* clause. With a second by Councilman Wilson, the motion carried by voice 7 to 0.

Mayor Weiss presented the 2016 Salary Ordinances as follows for Council's approval:

Ordinance 2016-2 titled: *Ordinance fixing the rate of compensation and benefits of the Police Union Employees of the City of Greendale*. There being no discussion, at 6:40pm Councilman Bowell made a motion to approve Ordinance 2016-2 contingent upon the union approval of the *Police Union Contract*. With a second by Councilman Mollaun, the motion carried by voice 7 to 0.



There being no discussion, at 6:41pm Councilman Wilson made a motion to approve Ordinance 2016-3 contingent upon the union approval of the *Civil Union Contract*. With a second by Councilman Abbott, the motion carried by voice 7 to 0.

Mayor Weiss presented Ordinance 2016-4 titled: *Ordinance fixing the rate of compensation and benefits of the Non-Union Employees of the City of Greendale*. There being no discussion, at 6:43pm Councilman Bowell made a motion to approve Ordinance


2016-4 as read. With a second by Councilman Karsteter, the motion carried by voice 7 to 0.

Mayor Weiss asked if there was any Unfinished Business or audience comments. There were none. Mayor Weiss announced that effective February, 2016 all board meetings will be in the new City Administration Building.


There being no further business to come before the board, Councilman Wilson made a motion to adjourn. With a second by Councilman Mollaun, the motion carried by voice 7 to 0.

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
