GENERAL SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Civil City Superintendent, will be assigned such duties as wood chipping, painting, mowing / weed eating grass, hand digging, performing street sign maintenance, general construction, and general cleaning duties.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Must have ability to follow instructions and complete work assignments in a timely and efficient manner.

Must properly maintain all tools and equipment that are used for work assignments.

Must observe and adhere to all posted "work rules" and safety regulations to complete work assignments.

The employee is expected to wear safety items associated with work responsibilities.

Complete all necessary job and safety training as required.

Perform all other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES

Ability to use hand tools and learn to use assigned tools and take instructions for learning new job skills. Must be able to receive and work in a manner that will maintain cooperation and obtain satisfactory work. A valid Indiana driver's license is required.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

The physical activity expected is balancing, stooping, crawling, climbing, kneeling, reaching, standing, pushing, pulling, lifting, talking, and repetitive motions.

Must be physically, mentally and psychologically able to perform all of the required duties. Position requires physical strength, finger and limb dexterity and mobility.

Must be able to lift weights of up to 90 pounds.

Required to take and pass a pre-employment physical and drug examination.

WORKING CONDITIONS

The minimum working conditions require the employee to work both inside and outside, exposed to noise and adverse atmospheric and environmental conditions. Must be able to perform heavy manual tasks under adverse weather conditions.
