Mayor Weiss informed Council that the **I-275 Entrance Beautification Project** has rematerialized after 2-3 years. Terri Randall, One Dearborn is leading the project. She briefed Council about what Phase I of this project entails: 1) Signage; 2) Painting poles; and 3) Clean-up, Weeding, Mowing with Landscaping and Engineer Bidding. She indicated that Casey Knigga is also on the Board for this project. He stated that this project is the *Gateway to Southeast Indiana*. In conclusion, Ms. Randall is looking for a commitment from the City of Greendale to get this project started. She indicated that Phase I would basically include maintenance of the entrance.

After lengthy discussion. **Mayor Weiss asked that Council think about whether they want to commit to this project. He asked Council to forward comments and questions to him.** Casey Knigga stated that after the City of Greendale makes a commitment he can get an idea of how much Phase I will cost and what is required.

Mayor Weiss and Council are in agreement to move forward on the I-275 Entrance Beautification Project, subject to more information being provided from One Dearborn and the Greendale Redevelopment Commission.


Under other business, the owner of the State Line Motel and Car dealership appeared before Council to give them the opportunity to purchase these properties. He feels that the City




